How Galaxen Bygg can support you

As a person who has recently arrived in Sweden or is long-term unemployed, Galaxen Bygg can help you to find a job in the construction sector. In some cases, you will have the option of taking up an apprenticeship with training to obtain professional qualifications.

We find out about your goals and work experience and match these to the needs of the employer.

To be relevant for Galaxen Bygg, you must above all be interested in working in the construction sector – for example as a carpenter, painter, electrician, HVAC installer or structural engineer.

To apply for Galaxen Bygg's support, you need to fill in an application form and send it to the right contact person where you live. Once we have received your application, we will meet up to discuss your background, knowledge and experience. Then we will work with you to find a suitable job. If we find a good match with an employer, Galaxen Bygg will help with the employment documents and getting you settled into the workplace, and then will regularly check in with you to see how things are going.

The Employment Office will consider the situation and decide on any financial support for the employer, depending on the type of employment. The aim is that you will eventually have a regular job with no subsidies.

Galaxen Bygg is run entirely on a non-profit basis and has been operating since 1986. Each year, we help around 500 people into employment. Contact us to find out more!

Terms for new arrivals:

- You must be registered as a jobseeker at the Employment Office.
- You must be a new arrival according to the Employment Office's definition: a jobseeker who has received a residence permit within the past 36 months.
- It is a bonus if you have experience in construction, but if not you just need to be interested in beginning a career in the construction sector.
- You must be able to communicate in Swedish.

Terms for long-term unemployed:

- You must be registered as a jobseeker at the Employment Office.
- You must be long-term unemployed according to the Employment Office's definition: You are at least 25 years old and have been unemployed full-time for 12 months. You are 15–24 years old and have been unemployed and registered as a jobseeker at the Employment Office for at least 90 days over a four-month period.
- It is a bonus if you have experience in construction, but if not you just need to be interested in beginning a career in the construction sector.
- You must be able to communicate in Swedish.
